Introduction to the Australian Curriculum for Languages

UPDATE FROM ACARA (September, 2015)

- the Education Council endorsed changes to Foundation to Year 10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards for English, mathematics, science, humanities and social sciences, the arts, technologies and health and physical education. These changes address two key themes from the recent Australian Curriculum review -
‘resolving the overcrowded curriculum’; and ‘rebalancing the curriculum’.
- Foundation to Year 10 Australian Curriculum: Languages for Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Modern Greek, Spanish and Vietnamese, and Work Studies

Years 9-10 were also endorsed by Council.

- ministers noted that the revised curriculum will be published on the Australian Curriculum website in mid-October. State and territory school and curriculum authorities will determine the implementation timelines for their schools
- NOTE: languages to follow are Turkish, Hindi, AUSLAN, Classical Greek and Latin.
